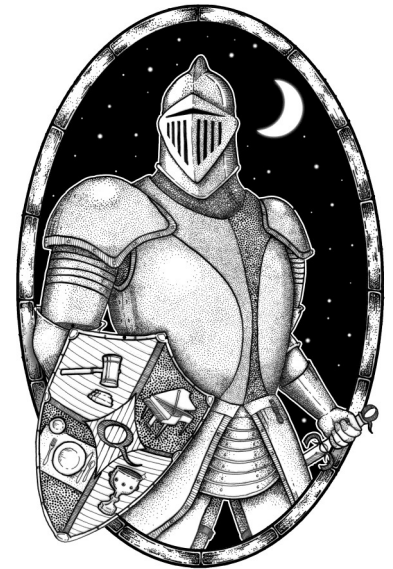

## Bingo Was a Blast!

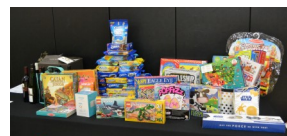
Thank you to everyone who joined us at the Family Bingo and Auction Gift Gathering
